Naama Shilo, 45, is a community social worker by profession with extensive experience working in the humanitarian field.

For four years, she held the position of the Chief Executive Director of Brit Olam – for international volunteering and development in art, agriculture, and health.

For six years, Naama served as the Director of Operations of NATAN and managed the emergency operations for disasters area on behalf of NATAN, including the operations in Haiti, Philippines, and Nepal, aiding Middle Eastern refugees in Serbia and Greece, and was involved in fields operations in Haiti, 2010, Nepal 2016 and Ukraine 2022.

For four years, Naama was the professional development director of project TEN – developed the field educational model of the projects and managed the project's centers staff and overall activities.

With years of experience in working with Israeli NGOs, developing several international projects, working with communities in Israel and across the world, managing large scale of staff and volunteers, and operating several relief operations, Naama took on the role of the first CEO of NATAN in August 2022 with great belief in the organizational mission and pride in NATAN's unique spirit.
