Danny Kahn is the Chairperson of NATAN Worldwide
Disaster Relief. His resumé reads of a lifetime of restoring
dignity and respect to people around the world. Born in
Paris to a Jewish family, Danny attended the Hebrew
University in Jerusalem where he studied Education and
French Literature. While at school he began his life of
service and education at the Ministry of Labor where he
was a coordinator for a juvenile delinquent rehabilitation
program. He went on to become the director at several
community centers and Consultant for Education for the
Chief Rabbi of France. Following that, Danny was named

Director of the Training Division for the World Zionist Organization. Eventually he was asked to apply his experience and knowledge in the Israeli Intelligence Service. For twenty years Danny was deeply involved in international relations with long-term missions in North America, Southeast Asia, Europe and Africa. Among other duties he helped lead the rescue of Jewish communities in Muslim countries. Before joining NATAN, Danny was named the Director of International Development, Geneva, of World ORT, one of the largest education and training non-governmental organizations in the world, where he ran rescue and development projects in Haiti, Mali, Niger and Guinea. Danny and his wife, Dolly, have been married for 50 years. They have three children and seven grandchildren.
