

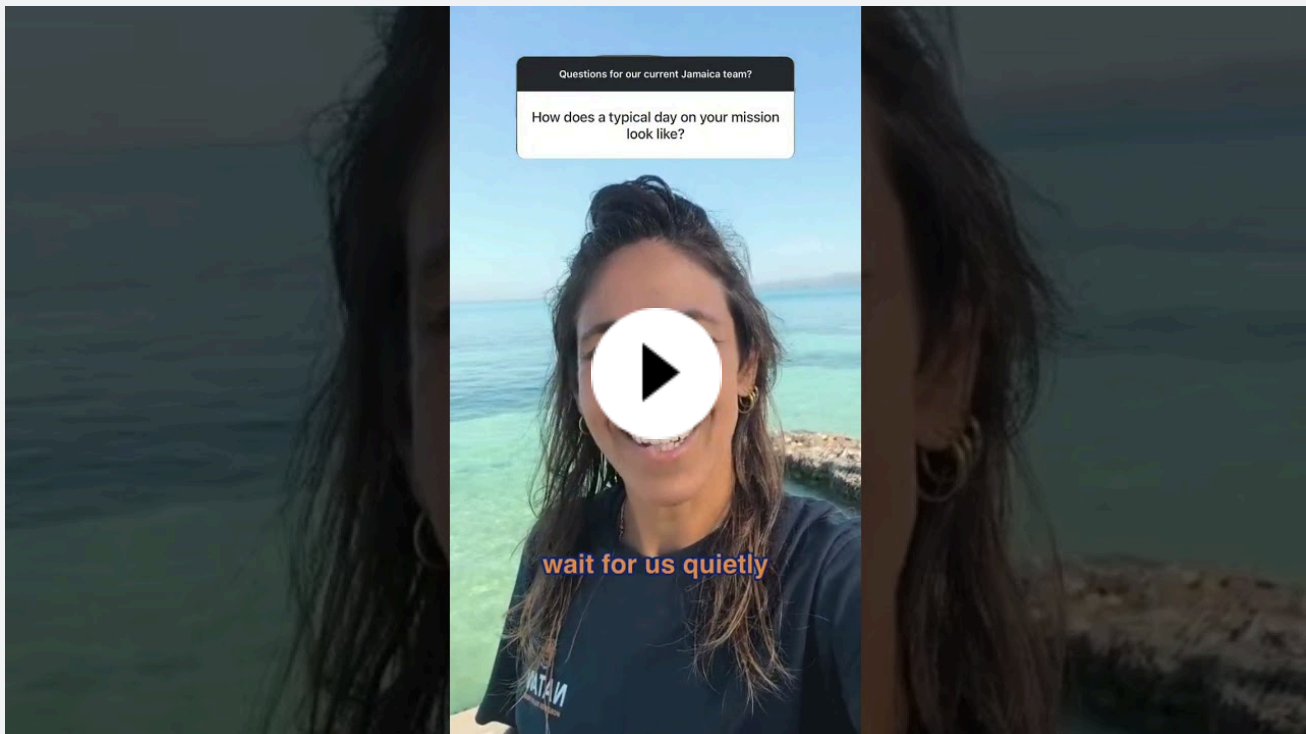

NATAN on the Ground: Third Mission in Jamaica

Hear from Dr. Maayan Bacher, a NATAN volunteer in Jamaica.



NATAN volunteers have been working in Jamaica since early November; three teams have provided medical and psychosocial support to more than 600 local residents, including the grandmother of Olympic champion Elaine Thompson-Herah.

Our priorities? Providing urgent healthcare to isolated, underserved communities -- many inaccessible by road.

In coordination with Operation Blessing, Medic Corps and the Jamaica Defence Force, NATAN teams have flown into remote mountain villages to provide triage and care. Mobile medical clinics serve patients in St. Elizabeth and Manchester parishes and in Montego Bay, with resilience-building psychosocial efforts centered in Black River and Adelphi.

Logistical support from AirLink permits NATAN to maintain uninterrupted, essential care to vulnerable communities.
