CELEBRATING PEACE -- AND SENDING HELP

Soon after the earthquake struck the Philippines, NATAN volunteers joined forces with **Operation Blessing Philippines**, tending to hundreds of survivors on the island of Cebu — a long, narrow stretch of jungle now dotted with improvised shelters. Fear of aftershocks keeps many families sleeping outdoors, while local officials call urgently for psychosocial support, tents, and engineering assessments.

Together with international and local partners, NATAN is responding with medical and psychosocial aid — with clinics that treated over 110 patients in a single day to training in resilience, self-care, and emotional “first aid” for youth volunteers supporting their communities.

As words of a fragile **ceasefire** begin to echo at home, we are reminded that our mission transcends borders — **bringing care, dignity, and hope wherever people are rebuilding their lives.**

Without the help of NATAN's generous supporters, this work would be impossible. Thank you for supporting our mission to respond to critical needs, wherever they arise -- far from home or in our own backyard.
